## **ConFlo Lines improves service to East Africa**

After a service suspension of nearly two years, ConFlo Lines announced a resumption of service to Nairobi (Embakasi terminal) Kenya and to Kampala Uganda via a partnership agreement with the carrier's agent in Mombasa. Through containers are being offered via US and Canadian East Coast and US Gulf ports with minimal transshipment and with a weekly sailing. The agreement was key in supplementing the carrier's North American container pool. With this service resumption, the carrier expects to stabilize rate structures against the ever increasing fuel costs.

Looking ahead, ConFlo Lines will be working to re-establish this service to other Kenyan and Ugandan inland points.
